The Shumiatcher Sandbox Series presents exceptional talent from across Canada and prioritizes the work of Saskatchewan artists. We are in the process of soliciting applications for next season's Shumiatcher Sandbox Series and we are interested in you and your ideas. We will select up to five (5) original pieces to present as part of the 2017|2018 Shumiatcher Sandbox Series.

The deadline for submissions is **Friday, October 7, 2016 at 5:00 pm.**

Submissions should include:

- An application form
- A preliminary budget that includes expectations for performance fees for a two week run (for out of town artists please separate out travel, shipping and accommodation costs) and;
- One page project proposal;
- Project synopsis (including development/production history and any other potential tour dates);
- List of any technical support you may need. See examples of a technical rider and design requirements for shows we present and/or produce.

In addition, applicants should include a list of the artists involved with their project and the CV's of the key initiators. Applicants are encouraged to include additional support materials such as photographs, a script, video clips, inspiring images, etc.
