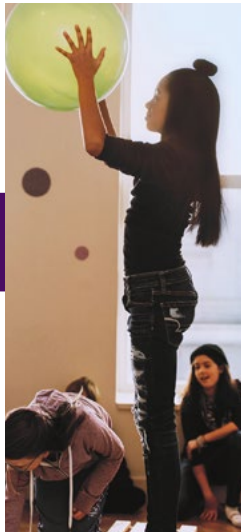

DEvised // AGES 13–15

This ensemble-based course drives students to rely on their peers as partners, collaborators and new friends. Under direction of professional artists, students are encouraged to leave their comfort zone and expand their perspectives. Students utilize improvisation, acting, movement and media arts to create an original piece of theatre.
