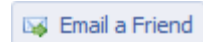
Fusion Project sparking creativity of young theatre talent

Seven young minds have come together to inspire and create theatre in the Globe's annual Fusion Project.

The project, which premieres Wednesday night, allows theatre students to use improv and drama techniques to create a short production from scratch.

"Through different creation methods like using different forms and different forms or music and music, we started creating this story," said 18-year-old Cameron Chomyn, a student who will be performing in the project.

Chomyn has been involved with the Globe's school since he was a Grade 11 high school student. He says working in Fusion is a way to test out your theatre talent and get a foot in the door.

"We are coming out of high school and thinking about what we want to do when we grow up. This is a opportunity to try out theatre for a couple of months," said Chomyn.

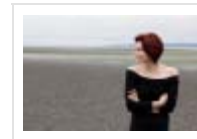
Except for Chomyn, who is a student at the University of Regina, all of the students participating are Grade 12 students from high schools around Regina.

"It's great to finally do something on a main stage where a lot of us have not had that opportunity before. We've had a little with our school drama performances and this is kind of the next level up," said Chomyn.

To create the show, students had to audition and meet on a weekly basis during January and February to improvise their story as well as inspire and receive dialogue from the director

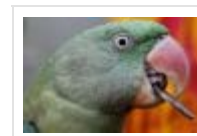

"Hopefully it tugs on the heartstrings a little bit. It's kind of a nice sweet story we've developed, so I hope there are some tears at the end of it," said Chomyn.


Fusion Project premieres on Wednesday at 7:30 p.m. at the Globe Theatre and runs until Saturday, tickets are \$20.
